Our September 28 Church Workbee rallied a large number of members and friends to pull weeds and begin the next phase of our landscaping project. Monies already donated for this purpose were used to purchase shrubs and flowers to plant along the south side and entrance of the church.

The result of this work has been so inspiring that many have felt the urge to take advantage of seasonal discounts and fall planting opportunities to complete the project along the east side of the church. To date an additional \$310.00 has been raised towards that goal. Additional shrubs have been purchased and planted, leaving about \$100 needed to complete the project this year. All landscaping to date has been covered by member donations that have been designated for this project.

Unfortunately, the promotion of this landscaping project has created some confusion and even feelings of broken trust in light of our agreement to make the installation of a church sign our first priority in our property development. I apologize for the misunderstanding that has been created. Please be assured that we are moving forward in the sign selection and fund raising process. Your generous gifts have already brought in \$700 for this important project.
