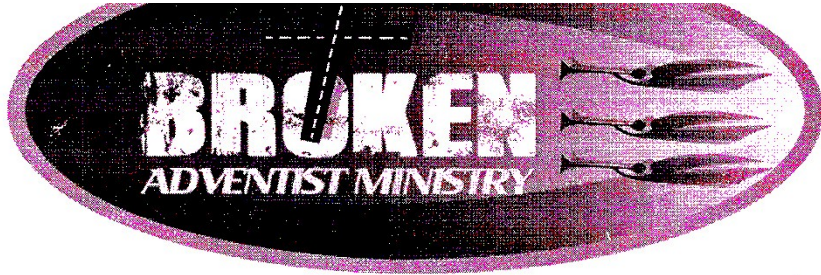
## Backpack Attack Project

  - Free Bible Studies either online, downloadable, or by mail.
  - Watch online sermons and other church-related videos.
  - Listen to or download audiobooks.
  - Watch video about mission projects.
  - Articles on religious liberty and Sunday laws.
  - A “bookstore” with free religious books (mostly used books), shipped at no cost to those who want them.
  - They also have Facebook, Live and Twitter accounts, etc.Use this freely with friends, neighbors, young adults, etc.
2. If you are downsizing, cleaning out or otherwise shrinking your library we can give your Bibles and religion and nature books a second life as an outreach tool throughout the USA:
  - No magazines, Sabbath School lesson quarterlies, etc.
  - Any book or Bible that you could purchase at the ABC is an outreach tool for BAM no matter how heavily it’s been used.
